THOUGHTS OF A CLASS TEACHER IN CHARGE OF YEAR 1

The first day of school..... Innocent and smiling eyes could be seen in the school campus. Tears were also in the rendezvous for some new students. But now, that day is over. Most of our new students are now familiar with the school regulations and rules.

Proper posture during writing

Flexion at the hips with an upright back. Eyes should be away from the desk (25cm - 30cm). Do not bend over the table; Leave your feet flat on the floor

1. Correct handwriting posture

Students should hold their pen using three fingers with their right or left hand: the index, thumb and middle finger in a 45 degree level

2. How to raise a hand

Left hand beneath the right hand and all fingers closed and up straightly

3. Making a line

The next one stands next to the first one and make a straight line. They should know how to reply when the class monitor gives them an instruction.

4. Greetings

Students should know how to greet teachers and visitors when they see them at school

Extracurricular activities

REGULATIONS FOR STUDENT SAFETY

1. Parents have to pick up students on time. In case parents ask relatives to pick up your children, parents have to call and inform the class teachers. The time to pick up students after school is 4:15pm. As for those students who attend the extra clubs, parents have to pick up children as per the time indicated in the club timetable.
2. Parents are not allowed to let children wear expensive jewelry to school. All student's belongings must be labeled with name and class. It is to avoid any lost. Students are not allowed to bring toys to school.
3. Parents have to prepare a drinking bottle for children, We want to avoid any diseases like hand-foot-mouth disease.
4. Parents have to slow down when driving into the school gate in the morning when dropping off children. All cars have to park outside of the school when picking up students after school. Only motorbikes are allowed to park in the school parking area. All cases of parking in front of the school lobby are not allowed.
5. Parents who want to visit the school canteen or send food and drinks to students have to drop by the security office for registration.
6. Students who want to move out of the school during the school hours such as going home for lunch, sick leave have to submit a pass permission with parents/ guardian and Principal's signatures.
7. Parents are not allowed to send milk tea or snack during schooling. This initiative is to keep students away from any food related problem. We also promote healthy alternatives at school.
