GENERAL REGULATIONS FOR AY 2017-2018

1. Students should go to school on time, starting lessons at 08:30 in the morning and finishing at 16:15 in the afternoon.
2. Students will have a general meeting once per month on Mondays of the 1st week of the month at 08:00 at the Multi-Hall.
3. Students will have life skills activities weekly at 08:00 on Wednesdays and Fridays at the Multi-Hall.
4. Students should wear proper school's uniform as per regulations.
5. Students are not allowed to leave school during schooling hours until parents come over and pick them up after classes.
6. Students will have lunch between 11:45 and 12:45p.m at the school canteen and might take relaxing, resting and playing freely within school areas, in the library and in the Multi-Hall.
7. As for students those who do not register for school meals, parents need to prepare food for students to bring to school or send to the securities before lunch for students. Food boxes must be carefully wrapped and labelled with a clear name and class for an easy delivery.
8. Students should not go home for lunch. If needed, parents have to sign a commitment letter to ensure the safety of student's travelling during lunch time.
9. Classrooms, canteen, hallways and playground are to be kept clean
10. Students are provided sport equipment for free activities during recess and after classes. All equipment must be placed back in storage after use.
11. All students property must be labelled with a clear name and class for an easy tracking when lost.

COMMUNICATION BETWEEN SCHOOL AND FAMILY

All students have a Handbook which is an important bridge of communication between the School and Family. In addition, it is a resource that keeps parents informed of homework and/or reminders daily.

Parents need to check and sign off on page 1 and on weekly report to confirm that the information on the Handbook has been read.
