OUR NOVEMBER

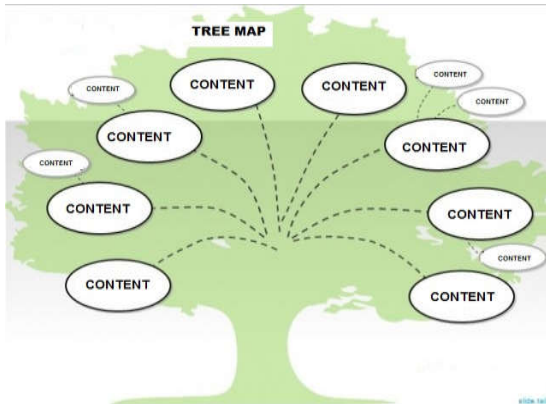

HOW TO GET A GOOD RESULTS IN YOUR EXAMS

Your school results in one semester depends not only on the process of acquiring knowledge but also on the test results at the end of that semester. So how can you achieve high scores in the upcoming first semester exam? We will refer to some of the following ways to learn!

1. Systemizing the learned knowledge with mind maps:

Systemizing the learned knowledge with maps will help learners see and remember what they have learned before more easily. We should use short, concise terms to present the issues. Avoid writing too much, rambling and over explaining.

2. Learning in pairs, in groups and cross-checking:

When studying in pairs, the groups need to ask everyone to study. Group learning will motivate us to compete with our friends. Besides, students will support and help explain to each other what they have learned and that they do not understand or forgot how to do.

3. Studying and sleeping at the right time:

Having a reasonable schedule of studying, playing and resting will help you prepare for the exam more effectively than leaving your schedule in a free-falling state. From early morning, students should say goodbye to their warm blankets and sit at their desk because this is the time when their body is most alert and lucid. Reviewing homework from 5am to 6am just before going to school, will help you remember the test content more clearly on that day.

4. Don't let the grass grow under your feet:

To get high results in your exams, students need to plan for consolidation from the start. That is right from the beginning of the course, just reviewing the knowledge and skills taught in class and keep your mind firmly focused on the "destiny" exam of your life. Making plans in detail for yourself on what you want to achieve each week, each month. It is better to review the lesson in a way that divides the content into smaller sections than rushing to study at the end of the exam. You can also write lesson content into small pieces of paper and read them anytime, anywhere.

IELTS – THE ULTIMATE ENGLISH TEST

Grade 12 is a year filled with high pressure for students across Vietnam and this includes our own talented final year students at SVIS. It also represents their final “formal” year of English studies and for this reason, the school has introduced an IELTS course, the ultimate test, in Grade 12.

IELTS (the International English Language testing System) is considered the highest-level test of an English language learner’s ability. It tests students’ ability to comprehend academic English, for example the ability to understand a university lecture, read a scientific text, write formal essays and be able to speak at length on a range of complex topics. The test is graded in bands to a level of 9.0 and in Vietnam, any student who achieves a score of 4.5 or higher is exempt from doing the national high school English exams. A score of 5.5 enables students to enter an English speaking university and 6.5 allows them to enter directly into an undergraduate degree.

The test is both comprehensive and challenging. Already, two of our students have taken the IELTS test with outstanding results, Phan Tuong Vy scoring 6.5 and Nguyen Le Hai Nhu 7.5. Their grade 12 peers have also shown considerable improvement and are mostly between a 5.0 and 6.0 level, impressive results for any 18 year old in a second language.
