SCHOOL READINESS

Each child develops their school readiness over time, therefore, the adjustment can be unsettling for both parents and children. It takes children lots of practice to grasp and retain a routine. We, teachers at SVIS, have lots of experience and are well-prepared to teach and equip elementary school students with knowledge. Patience, strictness and encouragement are key words to create an interesting learning environment for children. The English department at SVIS came up with some methods to maintain an organized classroom and ensure that students are comfortable, happy and engaged while successfully learning and practicing English.

- 1. **Develop an ESL Routine (and Stick to lt)**: the best way to control your elementary English class isn't to constantly discipline them, it's to create a routine and stick to it. Structure and routines tend to work well with young learners.
- 2. **Create activities for Classroom Management**: The best way to find the balance between being the cool teacher and the teacher pupils listen to is to come up with fun little games that catch your students' attention (while also getting them to participate in English).
- 3. **Keep Kid-friendly English Activities in Your Back Pocket**: A good elementary school teacher is one who's enthusiastic and comes prepared with a lot of activities. By following this routine, teachers at SVIS will become teachers that elementary school pupils listen to, as well as the fun teachers that they all love.
