

THE USEFULNESS OF PHONICS

There are 26 letters in the English alphabet. Each letter has a name and sounds. Learning letter sounds is an essential stepping-stone for our kids to learn because it will help them read English words. Our Grade 1 students have to start with the letters of the alphabet. First, they learn the names. Then they learn how to say the sounds of each letter. When they are already familiar with the sounds, they start combining them to read words. Little by little, they start reading different English words just by knowing the sounds. For example: letter Aa - the name is "ei" - the first letter in the alphabet and the first vowel. The letter alone has different sounds depending on the letters it is with in a word. It can be pronounced as /æ/ as in apple, /eɪ/ as in snake or /a:/ as in father. Phonics is useful not only for the lower grades but also for everyone. If we know the sounds of the letters, we will be able to read and pronounce words correctly. That is why phonics is useful. We love phonics.




ROBERVAL BALANCE AND REQUIRED SKILLS

Dear parents and students,

In the Natural Science subject of Grade 6, students learn how to use Roberval balance. We often use a mechanical scale or electronic scale to measure the mass of an object. These scales will make the measurement easier and more accurate. However, using Roberval balance will help students practice more skills.

First of all, I would like to briefly introduce the Roberval scale as follows: The Roberval balance (plate scale) is a type of scale which presented by the French mathematician Gilles Personne de Roberval in 1669. The Roberval plate balance is a type of scale used in education. Using a weight to weigh the equivalent weight of the object on the



opposite side (illustration). We will place a heavy object on the scale side, and at the same time place the weights on the remaining scale side. When the scale reaches balance on both sides, the total mass of the weights represents the mass of the object to be weighed on the scale.

Using Roberval scales not only helps students measure the mass of objects but also trains the skills for each student. Students are trained to be careful and persistent in their work. The ability to do guick mental arithmetic will help students a lot in calculations. Children will develop logical thinking skill when they know how to add (subtract) the calibrated mass depending on which side the object or the weight is placed. This measure method also helps students practice teamwork, discussion and criticism skills when their measurement results are different. In addition, using Roberval scale also helps students know basic knowledge of the "lever arm" in simple mechanical machines called Lever.

Therefore, when using Roberval scales in practical lessons, students are excited and all have a good learning spirit.
