Teaching Positively Through Games

Learning through games is an active teaching method. This is the method that makes students most interested in learning. In teaching Math, to make practice sessions more attractive and exciting, I have incorporated games into them.

Here the below is one of the games I have used: "Snake Game" in teaching Math.

Preparation:

- Snake game board.
- Dice corresponding to the number of teams.
- Group board.
- Question set.



Game rules:

- Each team sends a member to the podium (hot seat).
- Choose the answer by holding up the board.
- If correct, roll the dice and move the magnet according to the number of dots rolled. If incorrect, lose your turn.
- The winning team is the team that reaches the finish line first or has the highest number on the track.

Note: On the track, if you encounter a snake's head, slide down to the tail, if you encounter a ladder.
